Events at Julia Green

Invest Social (9/9)* The invest social is a parent-only party to kick off our invest campaign. Tickets are not necessary, and all parents are invited and encouraged to attend! Come meet other JG parents and enjoy drinks and a light dinner at the home of a fellow JG parent.
